



I'm really happy with my 6.7 build! The engine runs extremely well and the fuel mileage gains I'm getting are amazing. Loaded, my trailer is 30,000lbs and I've been hauling it around for years. I put about 35,000 miles on my truck a year. Before I got right at 8mpg towing the trailer. After breaking in the Speed of Air pistons I was getting 12mpg, a 50% gain! Once it got cold and started running winter blend fuel, my mileage dropped to about 11mpg which is still amazing. I get noticeably better mileage when I'm not towing but percentage-wise, it performs better when the engine is working hard.

I also like how much smoother and quieter it is now and have seen a noticeable drop in EGTs when I'm towing which is nice on those long climbs. Also the torque is way better than before-I'm passing 18 wheelers like they're standing still!
