

I was looking at options for a new engine for my 2008 Dodge Ram 3500, the truck is a work horse on the farm and spends most of its time hooked to a trailer. With that in mind I needed an engine that would be able to produce good power and fuel economy which presented me with a pretty difficult task. When I spoke with DFC about different options they told me about the new SPEED OF AIR Series engine, and after looking at a few other series I decided to try it out. Let me tell you I was nothing but impressed and happy with the decision I made!

First off, the engine ran incredibly quieter than before, I even had it running beside my 2012 and with both hoods open you couldn't even hear the engine idle over the other truck.
